Watchers of the Sea

Captain Denham was a pioneer of weather navigation in the 1800's and The Mount was an important look out post for 'Watchers of the Sea' as a signal station to record and report the weather for Fleetwood's port.

Visit the Mount and watch the ever changing sea views. Be creative and have fun making some sketches and paintings of the sea, land and sky.

ACTIVITY: Painting Sea Views

Take some paper, pens, pencils, paints or crayons up to the Mount Pavilion.

Choose a lookout point- there are benches and sheltered spots even on a windy day!

Sit and observe the sea and sky.

Fold your paper into small squares to make some rough sketches of different views, observe the clouds and sea.

Choose a view you would like to paint or make a 'mixed media' picture of a sea view.

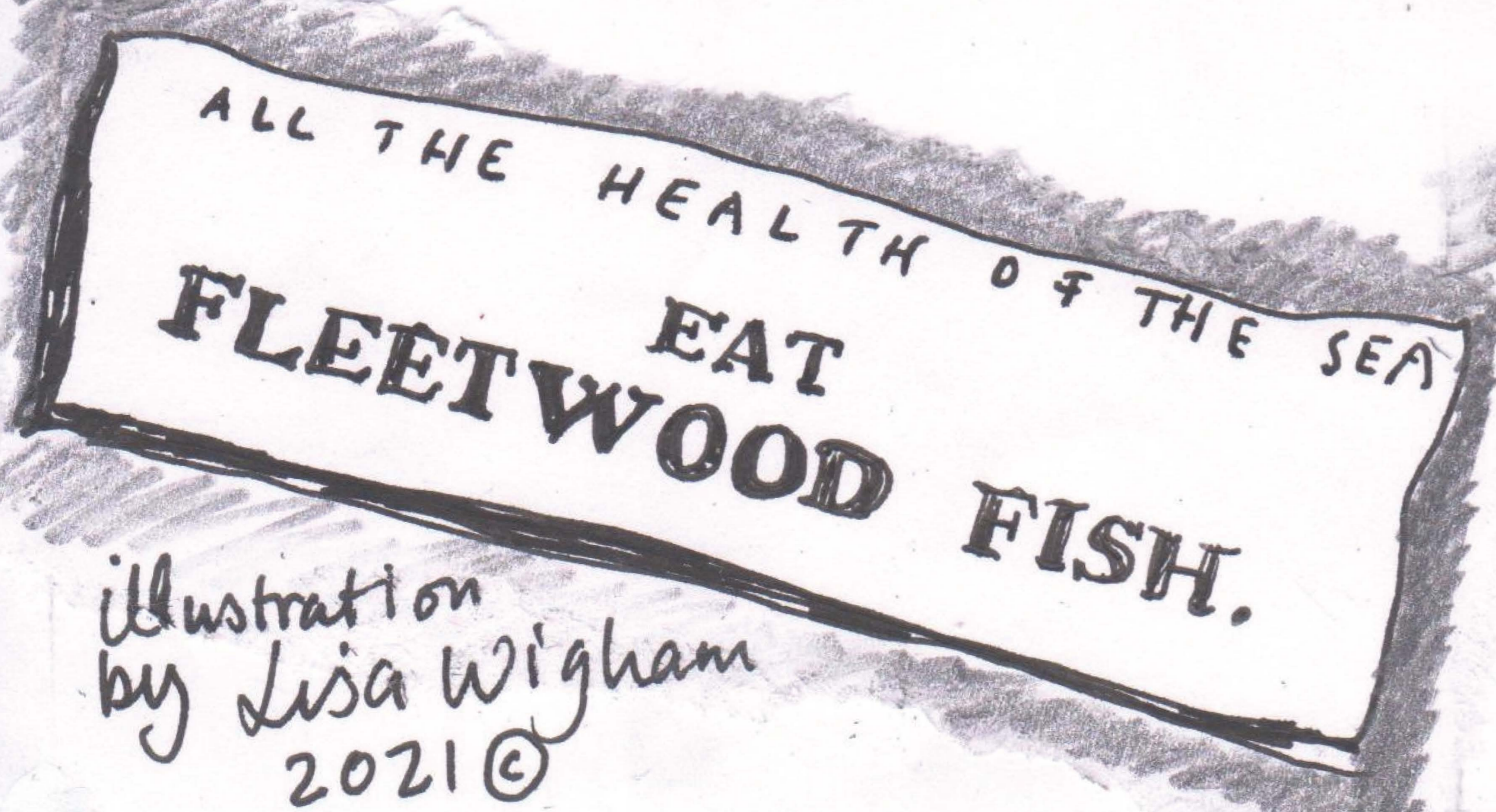
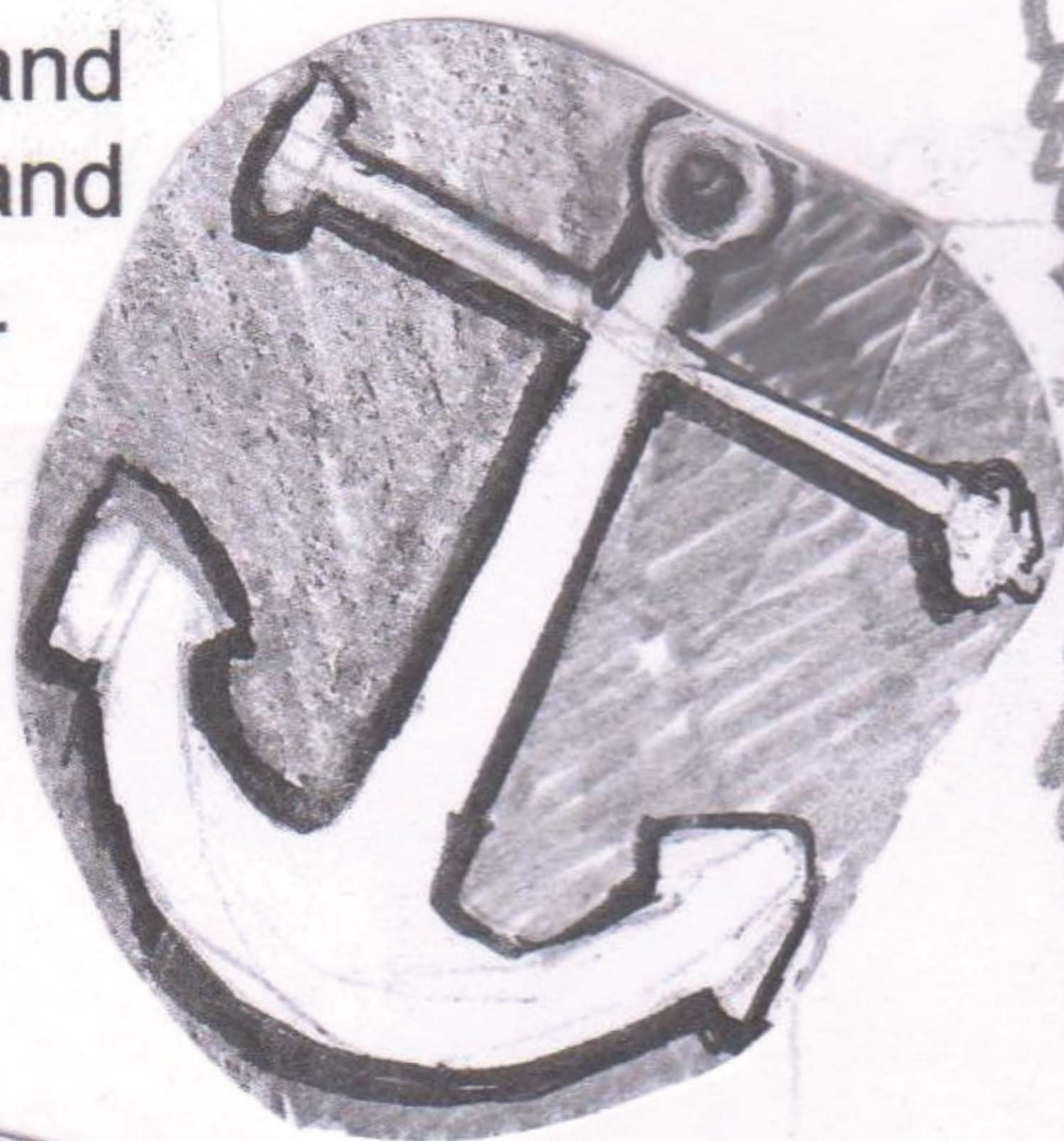
