Stop and listen to the wind in the trees, look for the insect life in bark or grass, see, touch, smell, what can you hear?

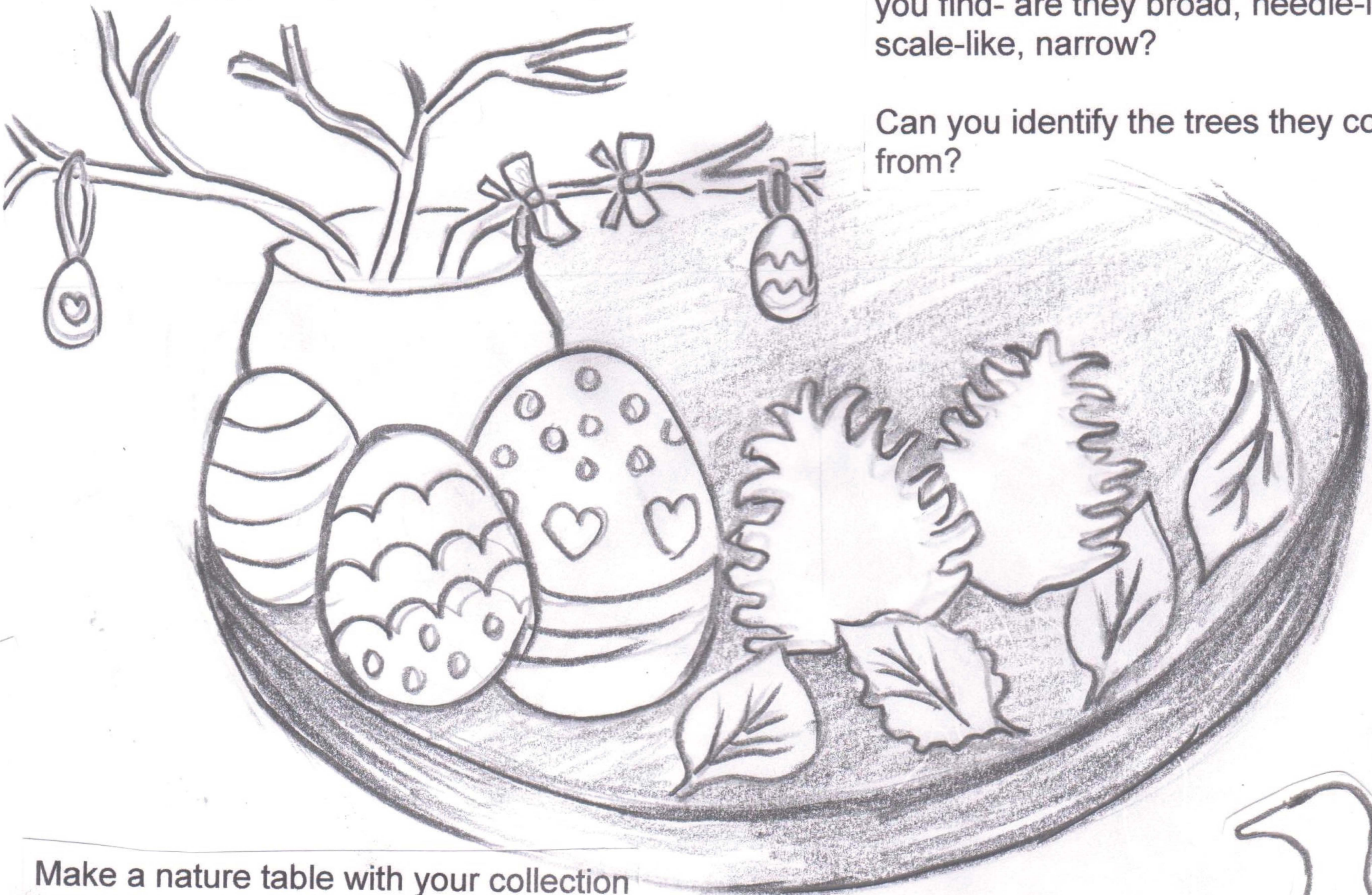
Activity: **NATURE WALKS**

Can you identify the trees they come from?



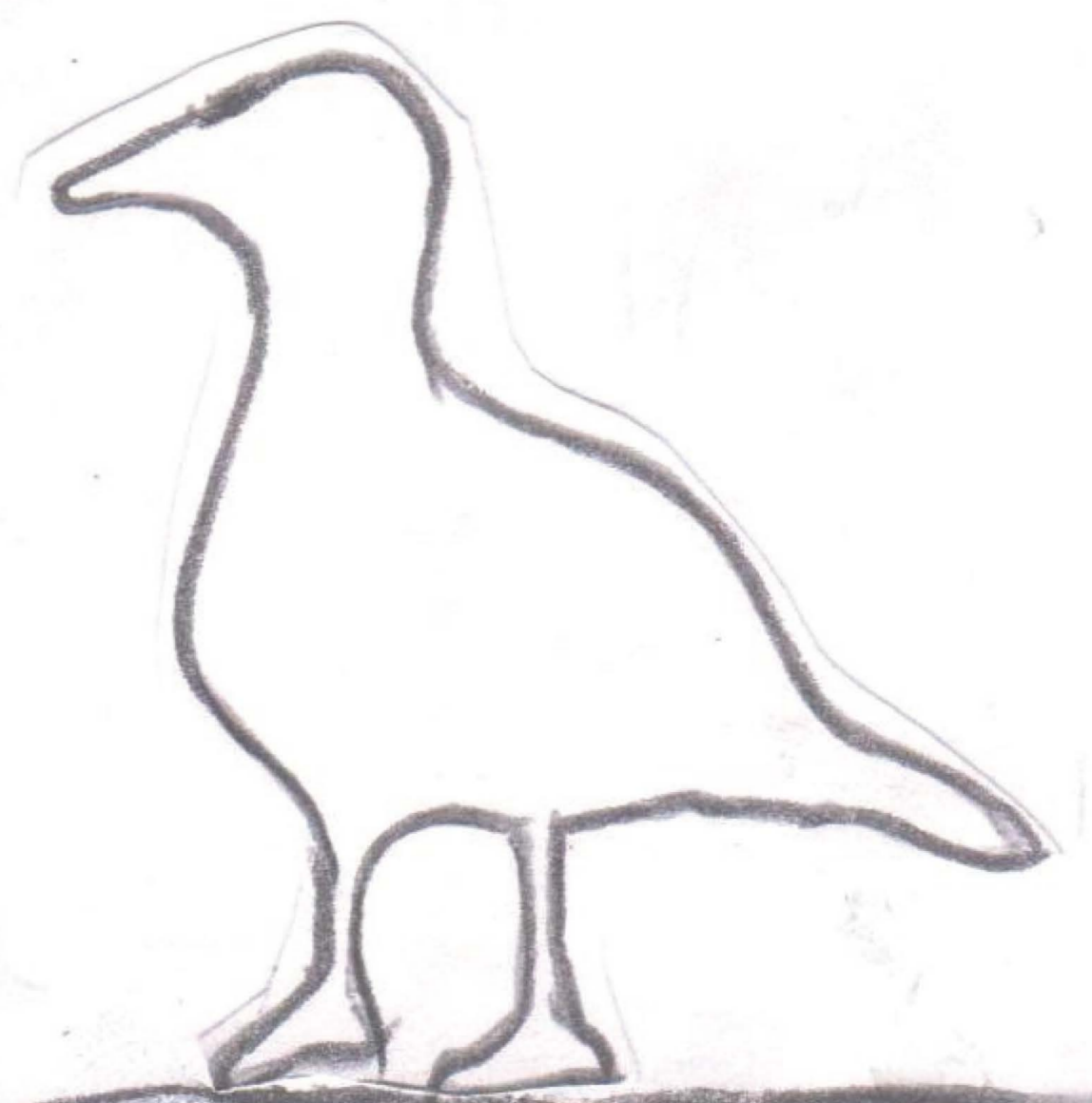
Make a nature table with your collection natural forms to celebrate the season of Spring in your home.
