



Finger Bugs



Handwriting activities using your own fingers
and legs

The writing activities in this book focus on children's own bodies. They help them learn to write, read, think, remember, understand, and solve problems.



Use your mouth!
Use your mouth to hold the paper and to hold the paper together to make the body of your bug.



Here's how to make Finger Bugs:

- 1** To cut a rectangle with one corner open to make the body of your bug.
- 2** Use your mouth to hold the paper and to hold the paper together to make the body.
- 3** Draw an interesting thing on the top, bottom, side, and tail from your bug template on sticky tape.
- 4** To make the body of your bug, hold the paper with both hands, behind your mouth, and pull the paper together to make the body.



- 5** To make your bug's legs, hold the paper together and use your mouth to hold the paper together. Then, use your fingers to hold the paper together to make the legs of your bug and to hold the paper together.

- 6** To make the body of your bug, use your mouth to hold the paper together and use your fingers to hold the paper together.

Why not draw with your mouth? Try to draw your own body using your mouth!
You can also draw with your mouth and use your fingers to hold the paper together.

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
