Here's how to make your Wildflower Bombs:

1. Collect seeds of some popular flowers like  
 cornflower, poppy, and wild radish.  
 (You can also use any other  
 flower seeds you prefer.)
2. Place your collected flower seeds into  
 zip lock bags and label the bags with the  
 name of the flower.  
 (You can use a paper bag if you don't have  
 zip lock bags, just make sure the seeds  
 don't spill out.)
3. Choose a small amount of soil from  
 your garden or a potting mix.
4. Turn your soil into the soil from step 3  
 and mix it well. (You can use a small  
 amount of water to help mix it.)
5. Place 10-20 seeds into each soil ball.  
 (You can use a small amount of soil  
 from step 3 to help mix the seeds.)
6. Place your seeds into the soil ball.  
 (You can use a small amount of soil  
 from step 3 to help mix the seeds.)



They are great for planting in a pot, in a garden, or in a field. They are also great for giving as gifts!
